MAXIMUM OCCUPANT LOAD

(TO BE POSTED IN A CONSPICUOUS PLACE NEAR THE PRINCIPAL ENTRANCE)

The Alberta Fire Code 2006 Division B, Article 2.7.1.3 states

- 1) The maximum permissible occupant load for any room shall be calculated on the basis of the lesser of
 - a) the number of occupants determined in accordance with Table 3.1.17.1. of Division B of the Alberta Building Code 2006,
 - b) the occupant load for which means of egress are provided, or
 - c) the occupant load as calculated and posted in accordance with the Alberta Building Code.
- 2) The number of occupants permitted to enter a room shall not exceed the posted maximum occupant load calculated in conformance with Sentence (1).

See sentences 2.7.1.5(1), (2), (3) and (4) of the Alberta Fire Code 2006 Division B which specify the required aisle and row arrangements for non-fixed seating.
