

## Policy 9 - Board Representatives

The Board may appoint trustees to represent the Board on various internal (Division) committees, external committees, agencies and organizations. Such representation is established at the discretion of the Board to facilitate the exchange of information on matters of mutual concern and/or to discuss possible agreements between the Division and other

organizations.

Board representatives to committees will not normally chair the committee.

Internal (Division) committees with Board representative(s) shall have a terms of reference annually reviewed by the Board.
